Property Maintenance

Most properties are natural habitat and require minimal maintenance, but fences need mending, sign have to be installed, boardwalks built and repaired and sometimes a kiosk or other building erected and maintained. Many of the long term tasks like dangerous tree removal, gravel for lanes and new fence installation are accomplished by our corporate partners but property maintenance volunteers are needed for short term projects and to help with the upkeep at the Grants Woods office.



Skills: at least a basic knowledge of one of the following: carpentry, plumbing, electrical, general repairs, ability to operate power tools &/or a chainsaw.

You will be responsible for your own safe, sturdy footwear & work gloves. Other safety equipment will be provided as needed.

Projects vary from season to season but may include:

- electrical repairs and basic installations (at Grants Woods office, electric fencing)
- building (kiosks, boardwalks, bridges)
- general repairs and carpentry (fences, existing structures)
- sign installation (transport or materials, post hole digging)
- plumbing (general repairs & maintenance)

Estimated time commitment: 5 to 10 days per year depending on the project(s)

Time frame: flexible, throughout the year, usually weekdays
